Upgraded crossing improves safety for Stoke Mandeville pupils

Over the summer holidays our existing crossing was upgraded to a parallel or 'Toucan' crossing which allows both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the road safely together. The works were carried out by Buckinghamshire Highways and were funded with money from the HS2 Road Safety Fund.

Mrs Stewart has said "As a Silver Award Travel Plan School, this new crossing is a welcome addition to our school environment



and will improve safety for pupils. It will further encourage our children and their parents to consider sustainable travel options such as walking, cycling or scooting instead of using the car."
