At Stoke Mandeville we believe that children require a positive reinforcement and understanding of expectations during a residential visit.

During the residential visit for its pupils, the school will:

- Provide a secure and safe learning environment where there are opportunities to access and achieve success in all adventurous activities.
- Develop skills that will enable its pupils to be successful
- Help pupils feel valued as individuals, build positive relationships and develop a sense of responsibility towards others
- Provide extra support where needed
- Ensure equality of opportunity for all pupils to participate in residential activities
- Deal promptly with any form of unacceptable behaviour that comes to our attention
- Treat pupils as individuals and recognise that they have individual needs
- Ensure the external provider is aware of any SEND needs a child may have

For its Parents and Carers, the school will:

- Keep parents informed of the activities being undertaken at the residential visit at a parents meeting before the trip takes place.
- Actively seek the views of parents to provide us with information which will help a child gain the most from the activities at the Residential visit.
- Ensure security of confidential information regarding the residential trip

As a pupil I will

- Follow instructions given by any adult
- Show respect to other pupils, staff and residential staff members
- Uphold the schools Values through the 5Rs
- Not deliberately cause hurt or offend any member of the Residential visit
- Co-operate fully with any request made by an adult
- Inform someone with responsibility of any concerns I may have about myself or others
- Behave in a safe way that does not put mine or anyone else's health and safety at risk
- Listen carefully to instructions and ensure I ask questions if I do not understand
- Always tell my group leader if I have a problem
- Take care of my belongings
- Be considerate of the need for everyone to be well rested for each day's activities

I understand that if I do not comply with these rules, I may miss out on activities or my parents will be asked to come and collect me.

As a parent I will:

- Provide the school with all confidential information it needs to ensure the child's needs are supported
- Work with the school to achieve its aims and reinforce its ethos, Behaviour Policy and Parent Code of Conduct
- Inform the school of any circumstances which may affect my child being able to access any of the activities outlined at the parents meeting.

In the unlikely event that my child endangers the safety of himself/herself or others by inappropriate behaviour, I agree to collect my child directly from The River Dart residential centre.
