'A King is Born' – KS1 Nativity

Tickets for our EYFS and KS1 Nativity will be going on sale on *Monday* **27**th *November*! These are priced at £2 each and will be limited to 2 per family per performance in the first instance. These can be purchased on School Gateway under 'Payments'. Please note that no physical tickets will be issued for these and all names will be held digitally by the school for checking off at the door.

Subject to availability we may release further tickets at a later date for families to purchase additional seats for other family members. Tickets are required for anyone requiring a seat at the performance including younger siblings. Babes in arms or toddlers on laps do not require a ticket.

Year 2 – Building Castles

We will encourage all children who bring cards into school to post them in the post box because the children are always very excited when the Christmas Post arrives in their classroom. Regular deliveries are made in the days leading up to the end of term. Last posting day is <u>Thursday 14th</u> <u>December</u> and final deliveries will be made on *Friday 15th December*.
