Parking

We have unfortunately received two local resident complaints this afternoon about parking on Marsh Lane and in the layby. Staff members had to go outside to assess the situation during this busy period and ask

cars to move. Three cars were parked on the zig zag lines and cars were parked on both sides of Marsh Lane seriously limiting access to cars and causing obstruction to any larger vehicles needing to pass. In an emergency fire engines or ambulance would not have been able to pass. Particularly on lovely afternoon like today there is no reason why parents cannot park further away and walk to avoid the serious congestion we had outside school this afternoon. Please consider walking, scooting, parking further away or car sharing. As always please photograph and report these instances of bad parking to both ourselves and the police or local authority and challenge bad parking where you see it.

Skipping Ninja

On *Friday 2nd February* we have Pete Thompson visiting the school - a Guinness world record holder in speed skipping! 'Skip Beatz' promote health through skipping to music, and are visiting the school to complete a demonstration and teach all of the children to jump, skip and lead healthy lifestyles! The skipping performance will include a show by a skipping ninja superhero! Skipping ropes, Ninja headbands, Ninja suits and skipping ropes will be on sale on the day of the workshop, with a shop at the end of the day accepting cash or card.

Roving Bookshop

On Tuesday children will bring a small envelope home with them linked to the Roving Bookshop which is visiting the school next Thursday (*Thursday 1st February*).

All classes will have the opportunity to visit the bookshop during the school day. If you wish to give your child the opportunity to purchase a book at the bookshop during the day, please could you put some money into the envelope, put your child's name on it and return it to school in the morning. Your child's class teacher will collect the envelopes in and then hand them out to the children when it is time to visit the bookshop. We have been informed that a lot of the popular books cost in the region of £7-£10 although there are also a number of half price books in the region of £3.50.

If you would prefer to choose a book with your child either before or after school, the bookshop will be in the room next to Year 5 from 8.30am and it will also be open after school from 3.15-4pm. If you would prefer to do this, then there is no need to return the envelope.

Books cannot be saved but if a title sells out, a paid order can be placed and the book will be sent later.

Online Safety - MyLOL

"The #1 teen dating website in the world" That's the claim of MyLOL, which offers 13 to 19-yearolds the chance to rate each other's pics, send private messages and contact strangers online. If that sets your alarm bells ringing, you're far from alone: law enforcement agencies and schools in several countries have seen fit to issue warnings about the platform.

Among the main issues is the fact that MyLOL doesn't have a reliable age verification method – meaning there's no foolproof way to stop anyone outside the platform's intended 13–19 audience signing up for an account under a false age. The attached guide from National Online Safety also highlights potential concerns around in-app purchases and the use of geolocation for sinister reasons.
