Leave of Absence

We have had an increasing number of parents taking their children out of school for extended periods over term time and would like to remind you that the Headteacher can only authorise leave of absence in exceptional circumstances. Schools will take into account Government guidance when considering what the exceptional circumstances are.

Taking holidays in school time is not acceptable so please check term and holiday dates which can be found on our school website.

The following reasons are not considered to be exceptional circumstances:

- availability of cheap holidays
- availability of the desired accommodation
- poor weather experienced in school holiday periods
- periods overlapping with beginning or end of term
- If you take a leave of absence without the permission of the school or if your child fails to return by the agreed date if permission was granted, then this will be recorded as an unauthorised absence and noted in your child's record.
