

Number Hunt in Jelly

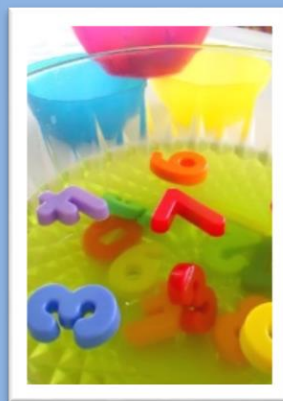


Materials

1. Bowl
2. Jelly
3. Plastic Numbers
4. Tongs

Activity

First, spread out some plastic numbers in jelly layers. When it is all set give the child some tongs to pick out the numbers and say the numbers as they find them. This is also good for fine motor skills. This is a fun activity for children and very good for number recognition. Can they sort the numbers into the right order? How many 8s did they find? What bigger numbers can they make? e.g. 14 or 23

How to make:



Using your hands,
break the jelly into
small cubes



Place the cubes into a jug and ask an adult
to pour the correct amount of boiling water
into the jug



Carefully mix until all the
cubes have dissolved



Put your numbers or letter into a bowl



And pour the jelly mix
into the bowl



Pour the correct amount of
cold water into the bowl and
place in the fridge
