



LEGO Tower Cards

 Set-up difficulty (1-5): 2

Improve pattern recognition and counting by talking through ideas for tower with the children which they can design and then build.

What you'll need:

- Paper cards
- Coloured pencils
- LEGO blocks

What you do:

1. Prepare some cards and explain to the children that they should draw a design for a lego tower, using different colours. You could give an example to get things rolling if need be.
2. Based on their designs, encourage the children to try and recreate the patterns with their own real-life LEGO block towers.
3. Great for pattern recognition and counting, you can get the children to help make the cards to begin with too.
