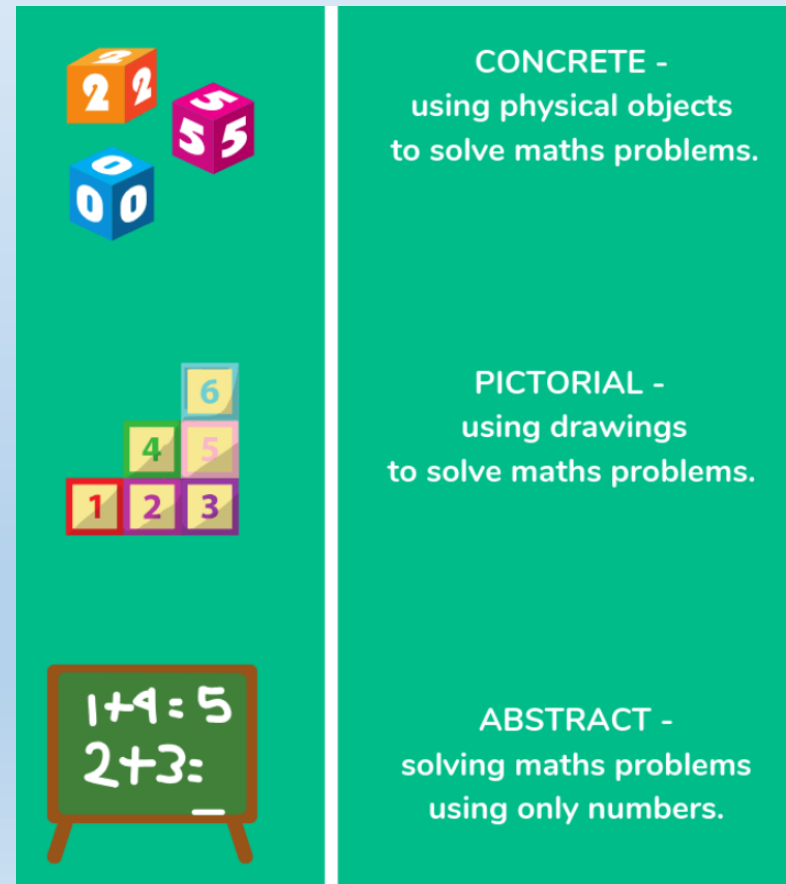
# Objectives:

- Concrete, pictorial, abstract



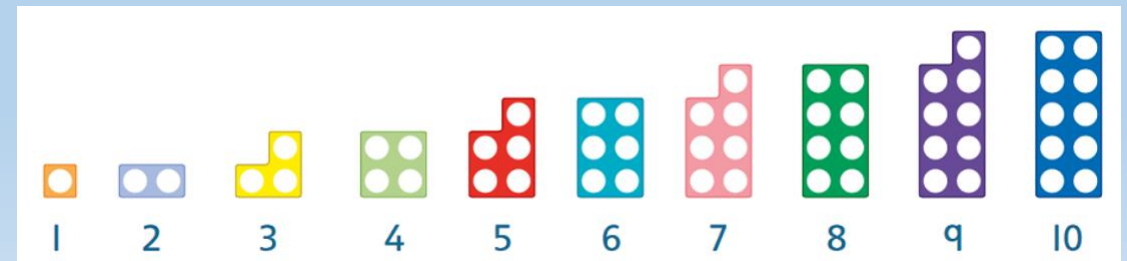
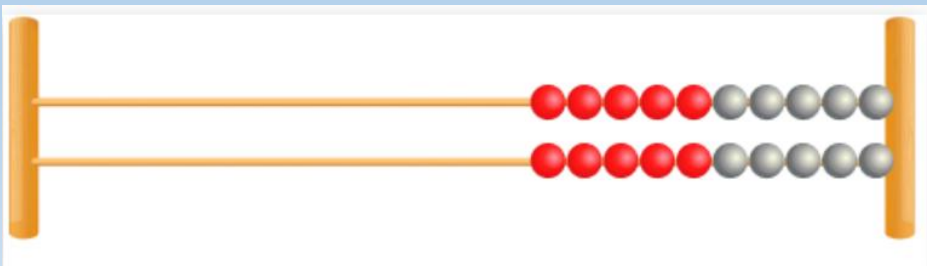
# Organisation:

- The children will need to be able to focus when the teacher is giving whole class input or instruction.
- You are encouraged to support your child/children during group activities and encourage them to share their learning with you.

# What you will see

- Reception: Activities inside and outside. Counting and subitising
- Y1: Place value. Resources in use: numicon, interactive whiteboard
- Y2: Activities involving money, including a money hunt.
- Y3: Games involving multiplying and dividing by 3, 4 and 8.
- Y4: Working systematically using multiplication and division.
- Y5: Multiplication squares problems.
- Y6: Algebra- finding missing values.



# How you can help at home

- Discuss prices when you're out shopping. Ask your child to keep a running estimate for the total of your bill.
- Find examples of fractions in every day life, such as in the newspaper.
- Work out how much time you spend doing different things each day.
- Make a timetable.
- Look at different temperatures when watching the weather, and discuss where is the coldest/hottest.
- Talk about supermarket offers e.g. 3 for 2 or buy one get one half price. Work out what the best deals would be.
- Small conversations, games, puzzles and patterns can make a big difference. They make maths relevant to the children.
